CUT YOUR ENGINES – Please help us address this issue.

Airborne pollution from idling car engines during morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up times causes significant health risks, particularly respiratory and cardiovascular diseases.

Children are especially vulnerable as they are close to the exhaust emissions of vehicles. Individuals with asthma are very susceptible but airborne pollution contributes to new-onset asthma as well.

Did you know?

Leaving your engine running when you're parked creates 20 times more pollution than when driving at 30mph!
